<u>Legacy the School of Sport Sciences</u> <u>Assistant Volleyball Coach - Job Description</u>

Each Assistant Volleyball Coach is responsible for (but not limited to) the following:

- 2. Arrive on time and attend at least 95% of practices and matches during the fall season.
- 3. Strive to be a valuable member of the coaching staff.
- 4. Encourage and uplift all athletes.
- 5. Attend any meetings regarding the volleyball program.
- 6. Be present for tryouts and any other preseason activities.
- 7. Transport Legacy student-athletes to and from competition sites.
- 8. Display good sportsmanship at all times; Uphold all rules and regulations set forth by the Head Volleyball Coach and Legacy the School of Sport Sciences.
- 9. Assist Head Volleyball Coach with practices (drills, skills development, strength training, and problem solving) as well as matches (Home and Away).
