Teachers are committed to...

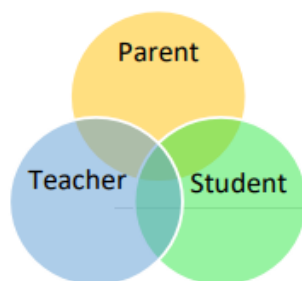
- Engaging your child in meaningful learning activities that lead to academic achievement and growth
